**I will be confirming the numbers with Tapton on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June, so if you are not down to play and wish to do so, please let me know by then!!**

Our next match at Tapton will be the first of our two doubles competitions in the WAGS season. In 1925, the land on which the Tapton Park golf course was built was gifted to the people of Chesterfield by a local wealthy benefactor, Charles Paxton Markham 2 years prior to his death. In May 2009, at the first of the inaugural Four Captains Charity Competitions, the 18 hole course was renamed the 'Markham Course' at a rededication ceremony in honour of the family. In 2009 the club celebrated its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary, whilst in the same year SIV acquired a 25-year lease for the course from Chesterfield Borough Council.

The Tapton Markham course is 6,104 yards long and has a par of 72. It consists of 3 par three holes, 12 par four holes and 3 par five holes. The holes range from the short par three 3<sup>rd</sup> hole, at 121 yards with a stroke index 17. The longest hole on the course is the par five 5<sup>th</sup> hole at 516 yards (this might require a little more of a throdge than normal), with a stroke index of 5.


