**I will confirm the numbers with Rufford on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> May, so if you are not down to play and wish to do so, please let me know by then!!**

Rufford Park golf course is 6,013 yards from the yellow tees and has a par of 70. The starting hole at Rufford starts with a Par 4, 361 yards, stroke index 8. Teeing off from an elevated tee box allows all of the members to see how your first shot of the day goes. So no pressure there then ☺. There are two Par 5's on the course, with the stroke index 1 hole being one of them. At 589 yards it certainly needs two excellent throdges to stand any chance of a par, let alone a birdie!! A somewhat shorter hole is the Par 3 17<sup>th</sup>, only 169 yards, sounds easy. However for those of you who have not played here before, maybe I should not tell you the tee box is very elevated and I mean very elevated ☺. Making sure you carry the rough going down the hillside and..... you are on the green. Well technically yes, but first you have to cross your fingers & toes and hope that your tee shot clears the lake surrounding the green. Oh, did I not mention there is quite a substantial lake protecting the green?!! I am sure all those members who have played Rufford Park will agree it has some wonderful holes. Good luck ☺

I guess to be in with a shot, you need a steady round, some excellent drives and chipping skills any professional would be proud of. Or in the case of one of my playing partners, good luck far beyond any that one single person should be allowed!! The 4<sup>th</sup> hole at Sinfin, as many of you know, is a Par 3, 182 yards, stroke

index 15. As many of you might agree, quite a straightforward Par 3 hole. Andrew's tee shot was a little short, just to the left of the green, Graham's tee shot finished straight but just short of the green and my own tee shot was also a little short, but to the right. So we didn't really frighten the green ☺. However, it was Graham's tee shot that had both Andrew and myself speechless. Graham stood on the tee, with his selected club in hand and stroked through his shot, hitting the ball cleanly. As we watched Graham's ball soaring in to the sky, it became obvious that the trajectory was, well how do I put this – a little off ☺.

Those of note were, Ges Meehan and Charlie Shilton, who carded 5 each. Going one better was Russ McLaughlin, with 6 gross pars. Beating this by two was Daniel Keen, carding an excellent 8 gross pars. But it seems we were in the presence of a master class, Mick O'Hanlon had the audacity to card, wait for it..... 11 gross pars, yes you read that right, I did say 11. I am sure you will agree that was an absolutely stunning achievement. Myself and some of the other long time members were trying to rack our brains and think if anyone had ever carded more gross pars. I remember an ex-member, Andi Mason, scoring 45 points at Kilton Forest in 2007, I had the pleasure of going around with him. But I just can't remember how many gross pars he scored. 10 gross pars had been achieved before, most recently by Russ McLaughlin on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2013, at Rufford Park. And also Charlie Shilton on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2013, at Springwater.



Looks like Andrew is getting in to full swing!!

As good as the gross pars were, it seems gross birdies were in short supply. Last year we carded 7 gross birdies, but this year we only carded 3!! These were carded by: -
